Jim Hille was appointed the first Chief Investment Officer of Texas Christian University (TCU) in May 2006. Formerly he was the Chief Investment Officer of the Teacher Retirement System of Texas, a \$100 billion public pension plan. From 1990-92 he worked as an assistant to the international portfolio manager at a large family office in Fort Worth while earning an MBA in Finance from TCU. He has served as president of the Austin Society of Financial Analysts, and an adjunct finance professor for the University of Texas' McCombs School of Business.
