Sue Winter

Sue Winter, a City of Fort Worth employee from 1981 to 2001, retired as Cable Communications Manager. She was elected to the Fort Worth Employees' Retirement Fund Board of Trustees as an active employee in 1987 and served through 1995. She was Vice Chair of the Board and chair of the Finance Committee during her active tenure. Sue was also one of the founding members of the Fort Worth Coalition of Retired Employees (CORE), an organization of retired general City employees.



As a retiree, Sue was elected to the retirement fund Board in 2007 and currently serves as Vice Chair of the Board and chair of the Communications Committee. She is also a member of the Investment and Personnel Committees.
